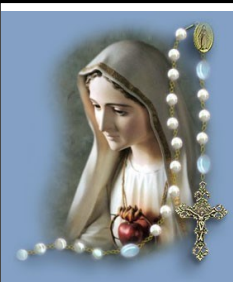

A Fun, Flexible, Faith-filled Catholic Club for boys ages 5-12.

The Blue Knights Catholic Club is a monthly boys' club aimed at teaching the truths of the Catholic faith to boys through Scripture, saints' biographies, games, crafts and *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*.
